REPAIRS done at the present time. The Yellow Metal and the Wood Sheathing stripped off: seven Strakes of Wood Sheathing next below the Wale renewed upon Fell: also Felled from thence to the Keel and Sheathed with Yellow Metal from lower Strake of Wale to keel being in Shores and Caulked throughout. Three after Woods of Bottom in each Buttock renewed all Treennails tried from Gunwales to seventh Strake of Bottom below Wale on each side and about 150 Fore-nails on each side in this space renewed: 3 after Woods of Tail Topside replaced: an extra Bolt driven into each Butt of Sheer and Black Strakes: Rudder tangings refastened; Chocks driven into Air Course to support Butts of Main and Ceiling. Lines &c. mended up.
