REPAIRS at present bottom stripped Caulked and recoppered with yellow metal on tarred paper. New hog keelson fitted inner Elm - two additional hold beams have been put in and six pairs of additional iron hanging knees fitted to the hold beams - and hold shelf fastened. Main Mast out & fresh and fore topmast refitted.
