## REPAIRS

At the present time. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Paper, Ship hung in Shores and Caulked outside. Five Pairs of Iron Staple Standards betwixt Decks, and Six Pairs of Iron Hanging Knees added to Hold Beams all through Bolted the latter with Bolts of Copper.
