REPAIRS now done of damages sustained by two Hurricanes at Madras, by being on Shore at Falmouth & Jamaica, also by collision with another Ship in the River Thames, which are more particularly expressed in Special Survey Report.

The Copper Sheathing stripped off, Ship hung in Shrou, Caulked throughout, and the Bottom re-sheathed with Yellow Metal upon the Greenails from Middle of Vales downwards to Bidges renewed, the Foremast Beams of Upper Deck secured to the Bows by Iron Plates upon their upper sides, a pair of Iron Hanging Timbers added there; a pair of Iron Strops introduced to support Quarters and Stern; Keel of Head and all attached to it repaired, a new Main Piece of Ribbon Channels secured, a Fore Head of three Planks, a timber Head and one Starboard abrest of Forecastle, Stale^d Bow replaced with new; and the Deck, Clamp additionally fastened.

Not of damage by accident. Two After Hoods in Larb^l Buttock replaced Present Condition of the Ship in good order and Bottom Deck, wedged up
