REPAIRS done at the present time. The Wood Sheathing stripped off the upper course of Bottom and not renewed, the whole of the Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and removed from Wale to keel upon Felt, three after-boards in Starb^d Buttock and two on the South^d side replaced with English Oak; the Iron Bolts in Lower Deck Waterway Logging and Hanging knees, and in the Shelf Piece Fore & Aft on each side replaced with Bolts of Yellow Metal, also the Iron Butte Bolts in two Lower Sheaves of Wale d^d a new Iron Knee to one Lower Beam in lieu of one broken, an Iron Gutch introduced, a Plank laid across heels of Stern Timbers, and Iron Knees upon it against Quarter and the Stern Post, two Tie Bolts introduced thro' the Stern and two after Beams, the Ship Caulked throughout and the Clamps and Bailing inside wedged up.
