REPAIRS done at the present time in complying with Special Survey Rule Sub. 54. 66 with a view to obtaining the 11 character.

The outside Plankings from yellow metal Sheathing upwards scraped bright & treenails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination & fastened or replaced on each. Iron replaced with new also a Plans of lower Sheer Strake in midship. Strake the latter six of last lower strake and the Deck Fastening Bolts in way of it properly examined. 324 feet of Upper Deck Plank examined with Particulars 3 which the Beams in way of it all sound. Clamps and Ceiling at Gun Ports, Checked, and the Paints additionally Bolted.

The Deck, Cramings, Deck and Hold Beam Bolts, Inside and outside Plankings, Treenails, Plank Sheen, Waterways, Beams, Trices, Mast Hooks, Bright hats, House Timbers, Keelson, Transoms, Plans and Timbers of the frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and in good condition. The general form is good and appears proper condition of the vessel.
