REPAIRS now done. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Felt, Ship hung in Shous, Caulked from Wals to Keel, The Main and Riding Keelsons being badly decayed (American Oak) have been entirely replaced the Main is of part East India Teak and Honduras Mahogany; the Riding Keelson of Stangey Back, all the Lower Fore Floors of Stave Ceiling from Lower Deck down to Keelson renewed, and ten lower Buttlocks repl the Stem Lark<sup>ly</sup> Six Stair<sup>ly</sup> replaced with new, also a new Sternson, a three lower Breast hooks and upper Piece of Cedar wood repl the Stem Frame all of English Oak, an extra Butch of Iron introduced. one of the Breast hooks is of Iron.
