 one House Timber and thirteen fillings, betwixt timbers in the  
 above space of English Oak.

Sailed The four Stakes of Topside to near Fore part of Main Channel  
 of East Tack, 120 feet in two upper stakes of Main, and 70 feet in two Black  
 Stakes new under Fore Channel of Danish Oak, Sail & East Tack; one  
 House Timber and twelve fillings, also two Top Timbers in way of  
 the above of English Oak; both Main Heads and Cheeks off and on again  
 Caulked outside above Copper
