At the present time, the Yellow Metal stripped off and renewed upon Felt from Wale to keel, Caulked throughout, 52 feet of Upper and 52 feet of Lower Black Stake renewed with Red Pine Fir in Midship on the Starboard side, also 29 feet of Lower Black Stake in Midship Laid, the Timbers in way of d^o good

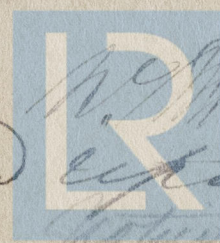
