REPAIRS at the present time of damage sustained by being on shore in the River St. Lawrence.

A new Lower piece of Stem, and extended so as to form a new fore end to damaged portion of Main Keel, the new Piece is of very Superior English Elm 2^{ft} 0ⁱⁿ moulded in the largest part and 19^{ft} 0ⁱⁿ in length well fitted and secured, Yellow Metal and Wood Sheathing stripped off and renewed at Keel Seam, Gunboard Strake and Head ends, Sheer hung in shores and Caulked there, the Gripe refitted, about 40 Feet of False Keel for^r renewed and repaired at other parts, an Iron Rider fitted over fore end of Keelson and new Scarp of Keel so as to secure the foremost Floors, three new Hold Pillars, the Caulking of Main Bottom tried at the Bilges and found to be good.
