REPAIRS at present bottom stripped. the three after hoods of Cen plank renewed timbers exposed sound one admt. bolt of Copper driven in stern post and dead wood, two after hoods in starboard buttock renewed of English oak - all the bilge ceiling planks amidships and two planks of Culity above the bilges and several planks new in flats of Culity of Amer Cen 31 new head wheel chocks and 5 new filling timbers in bilges - 1500 treenails renewed in both bilges - and bilges additionally three bottom bulk Copper - Caulked from the keel to the wales & sheathed with metal or paper
