At the present time, the Outside Planking from Copper upwards scraped bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination about 100 Sheets of Copper exposed in repairing. Caulked from Copper upwards to second Seam of Decks next the Watway; a few Treennails in Wales and Topsides replaced.

The Deck, Coamings, Deck and Hold Beam Bolts, Inside and Outside Planking, Treennails, Plank sheer, Watway, Beams, Knees, Breasthook, Knight heads, ~~Breasthook~~ Hawse Timbers, Keel, Keelson, Transom, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and are in good condition; Her Store and general Store appears preserved.
