REPAIRS at the present time of damage by being on the Bar at Demerara  
also by collision with the Schooner employed tightening her more particulars  
of which are in "Special Report."

The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Felt  
False Keel entirely new, a new Head to Stern Post and the Steel  
secured to Keel; a new Fore Head of Bottom Stanch<sup>l</sup> Flat and other  
Planks repaired where necessary; two broken Hanging Knees to hold  
repaired Ship hung in Shows and Caulked from upper edge of  
Wales to Keel.

Not of accident. Three Strakes of Wood Sheathing upon Felt  
now introduced next below Wales.
