REPAIRS

Done at the present time in complying with Special Survey for Continuation Rule Sec W 54. The outside Planking from yellow Metal Sheathing upwards scraped bright. Iron Bolts and Treennails driven out at various parts for examination. Knee of Head and all belonging to it new; two Planks of Toppers replaced, 27 feet of Main Keelson new of African Oak, Wales and Sheer Strakey Caulked.

The Deck, Coamings, Upper and Lower Deck Bolts, Inside and Outside Planking, Treennails, Planksheer, Waterway Beams, Knees, Breast Hooks, Knighthead, House Timbers, Keel, Keelson, Transoms, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and are in good condition, her original Form appears to be preserved.
