REPAIRS

at present scraped bright from yellow metal. up - on the starboard side four after hoods of bottom and the strake of bottom under the wales all for raft and one length of wales under the fore rigging now shifted being worsened and renewed of Quantic fir. Treennails all new from Copper up - a 4" Plank fitted on Keelson - Yellow Metal Patched - The upper and lower deck bolts and the outside Plank thro which they pass the waterways and beams - the house timbers Nightheads breasthook and transoms the floors & Keelson the Planking outer from the light water mark upwards the Ceiling - the frame and inner surface of the outside Planking where seen are sound & good and the other appear general form of the vessel appear unaltered
