REPAIRS at the present time in complying with "Special Survey" for Continuation Rule Sec R⁵⁴. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Paper. Outside Planking from lower edge of Wales upwards scraped bright Treenails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination. Thirty of the Iron Bolts in Hold Beam Shelf replaced with Bolts of Yellow Metal, a new Lower Breast hook of English Oak and the Ceiling about it renewed. ~~two~~ Chocks introduced between keels of Timbers upon Deadwood close Aft and Bolted athwartship this outside Planking. Ceiling in Hold slightly Pieced and a few Graving Pieces inserted in sheer Strakes about Booms. The Vessel Caplin outside

The Deck, Coamings, Deck and Hold Beam Bolts, Inside and outside Planking, Treenails, Plank sheer, Waterway, Beams, Knees, Breast hook, Knight holes, Hancse Timbers, Keel, Keelson, Transoms, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and are in good condition. Her original form appears to be preserved
