REPAIRS at present bottom stripped treenail, driven out for survey above the bilge and found sound & good several bolts renewed in hanging knees of hold beams two pairs of strong drag-iron tiders fitted with hold extending from clamps to floor timbers new fore & after pieces of false keel fitted & put in in shores caulked from keel to gunwales and bottom sheathed with yellow metal or felt new main mast & new fore yard
