REPAIRS at the present time. The whole of the two Sheer Stakes (except their Fore Heads) new of African Oak. ~~one~~ each side and one Fore Head of Toppers and one Plank in Midship on the Port side new. Deck Fastening Bolts in way of d<sup>r</sup>. renewed twelve Chocks and Fittings introduced on each side to compensate for short and small sided. Top Timbers, Channels and Quarter Gallies taken off and refitted. Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Paper Ship hung in Shores and Caulked outside.
