REPAIRS

at present bottom stripped caulked and sheathed with yellow metal on timber. New Crutch of iron fitted New Main Mast put on board - The Wales topsides and sheerstrakes scraped bright and bolts & treenails driven out for survey and found sound & good - and the planks thro which they passed the plank sheers waterways and beams where seen. The house timbers Ruyghtheads breasthooks and transoms the floors & futtocks & keelsons the planking outside and ceiling inside the frame and inner surface of the outside plank sound and good and the sheer and general form of the vessel appear unaltered.
