at Present hold Cauling renewed between the breast hooks one half beam fitted in hold two new ~~Transoms~~ breast hooks fitted under and one new half transom in after Raft Port. New framing round the port one short after hood of bottom plank and several pieces in way of new transoms wood & yellow metal sheathing replaced in the afterbody - two new planks of quarter deck drifts - timbers exposed sound but Sappy - yellow metal patched on bottom - New fore mast and all new standing rigging furnished Bulk masts & rigging generally overhauled & refitted
