REPAIRS at present bottom stripped, Caulked from Keel to gunwales, bottom treenailed with 4 tenths on felt - 2 pairs additional iron hanging knees fitted to upper Deck beams - a pair of pointers and a crutch fitted to after body - hold beams additionally bolted to shelf ceiling furled up further out & fixed - Wales topsides & sheerstrakes scraped bright bolts & treenails driven out for survey found sound & good the outside & ceiling, Planks thro which they taken the plank sheers, waterways, beams, the main timbers, kingposts, breasthooks, transoms. The floors & keelsons the frame & inner surface of the outside planking where seen are sound & good and the sheer & general form of the vessel appears unaltered the tubes Sect. 54 & 60 have been fully completed with
