Now done. Copper Sheathing stripped off Caulked from keel to gunwale and the Bottom re-sheathed with yellow metal upon paper to three feet above high water mark which is within a foot of the Wales. False Stem Post additionally bolted and two lower braces of Rudder new of y metal and made to extend some home to rabbet and the lower on to the Plank of Bottom. She now appears to be fit to remain as classed.
