 Now done under Special Survey for Continuation Rule Sec 54  
 The outside Planking from lower part of Wales upwards scraped  
 bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for  
 examination.

The Deck, Coamings, Deck and Hold Beam Bolts, Inside  
 and outside Planking, Treennails, Planks here, Waterway, Beams  
 knees, Breast hooks, Knight heads, Hawse Timbers, Transoms, Keel  
 Keelson Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen  
 have been examined by us and are in good condition. Her original  
 Form appears to be preserved.
