REPAIRS at present bottom stripped treenails renewed from bilges up to Gunwale wales topsides and sheerstrakes scraped bright. Caulked all up - throat bolts of hold beam renewed of yellow metal - Keelsons rubbed bright bottom resharpened with yellow metal on feet above & under below - The upper & lower deck bolts and the outside & ceiling plank - the plank sheers water-ways and beams the main timbers knee heads breast hooks and transoms the floors & keelsons and the frame and inner surface of the outside planking where they are sound & good and the sheer and general form appear unaltered - Rule Sect 34 Complied with
