REPAIRS now done of Damage sustained by being on Shore off Kings-down in her passage from Antigua to London more particulars of which are in Special Report.

Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom and renewed upon Felt to light water mark; one new Pinle and Brace to Rudder Bulwark and Keel repaired. False Keel which was lost not replaced. Four Stakes of Guiting at each Bilge in Main Body removed and replaced English Oak and East India Teak, one Inch thicker than original viz two Stakes of 5" one of 4" and one of 3". 16 angular Chocks on each side at Floor Heads replaced with more efficient Chocks fully compensated for one First Buttack on the Starboard side and five on the Port side which were found sprung but not near each other, two pairs of Iron Riggers have been introduced diagonally extending from Deck Clamp across Bilges receiving two Bolts in Floor heads to strengthen her the vessel being full and burthensome, hung in shores and caulked throughout
