REPAIRS at Present wood and Copper Sheathing stripped off and old bottom made good and Caulked and fitted and doubled from the Keel to the Wales with 2 Amer Elm fastened with  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch <sup>3/4</sup> metal in every timber and a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch bott of yellow Metal every 5 feet - false Keel removed & Middle line bolts overboard New Hog Keelson fitted of Teak iron bolts - Plank of topsides in the range of Chain bolts & Scuttles removed and new teak Plank fitted solid bulwarks removed and all new Plank sheers with new wrought iron rails and bulwark fitted all new Channels & Channel bindings fitted Caulked all over and bottom sheathed with yellow Metal Ceiling repaired - Hull, Masts, & Rigging generally overhauled and refitted - Section 54 & 60 Complied with sheer and general form unaltered.
