all new bolts in Hople Hand arms, & Helms new Chain bolts  
and Iron work of rigging overhauled -

The new lower deck Beam and half 110 with knees  
all new fastenings to lower deck knees, and 5 pairs  
of Iron hanging knees added. The upper course of the
