Present found all new their strokes, except the after lengths new Bottom in upper deck knees, new stroke on each side of the topsides, except the after planks, new bolts in the throats of the knees of the Hold Beams, all new decks, caulked from the Copper up, and generally overhauled

Windlass down. — Has been surveyed in conformity with the local Rules Section 54 & 55. The upper deck (new) the comings, the upper and lower deck bolts, the outside planks through which they pass, the planks sheers, water ways, Beams, Hauler timbers, Haulage Beams, Mast Stacks, Transoms the floors, Kelson, the plankings outside the gunwales passing through from the Copper up the ceiling the frame and inner surface of the outside planks all in good condition the keel is straight and the sheer small.
