REPAIRS

At the present time at the suggestion of the Surveyor
 new treenails from below the bilges up to the gunwale, new
 length of sheer stroke on new fore shift of wale, new
 throat bolts to the knees of the lower deck of Iron the ^{deck} ~~upward~~
 was caulked, Pintles & braces refastened, shipped caulked from
 the keel up & sheathed with yellow metal upon paper, a pair of
 knees of iron to the head — Surveyed in conformity with the
 the ^{sections 34 & 65} Society's Rules, Scraped bright from the light marks of
 bolts & treenails driven out for inspection

The upper deck plannings, the bolts of both decks, the planks through
 which they pass, the plank sheers waterways, beams, Hawsers & strops
 posts, Mast Hooks, transoms, floors & keelsons the planking outside from the keel
 up the ceiling frame and inner surface of outside planks where it can be seen
 all in good condition the keel is straight and the sheer unaltered
