REPAIRS At the present time 5 new deck beams & one clamped 5 new lodging oak knees, & two shakes of clamp on each side from the Foremast to the Mizzen Mast & two shakes of ceiling below the clamps, thereby hanging knees on each side rebolted
 On the starboard side 38 feet of shear shake, of beam; 240 feet of H sides, back & red Pine on each side, all new channel work 250 feet of new deck, & caulked from the Copper overall
