Present time topsides partly plank new Channels refitted

The upper and lower decks the comings the bottoms of the upper and lower deck bottoms and those of the Orlop deck beams the planks through which they pass. The plank sheers water ways and beams, House timbers Knight Heads, Quarter Deck transoms floors, Keelsons the planking outside from the Copper up the bottom to the main deck / from the Copper upwards the ceiling & the inner and outer surface of the outside plank where it can be seen all in very sound condition the keel is straight and
