REPAIRS

Now done. Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed, over Wood Sheathing: The Wood Sheathing entirely stripped off the Wale and renewed upon Felt: a Listing cut out at Hood ends of Stern and Stern Post, at Lower edge of Wale and Keel Seam, Ship hung in Shores Caulked at these parts, also Wale Toppers, and Deck Caulked; Forepiece of Main Keelson and Stemson new of English Oak, four lower Breast Hooks taken off (of Iron) two off them refitted and two replaced with new: three lower Fore Hoods of Ceiling new, lower part of False Stern or Gripe new: Fore and Main Masts, the Bowsprit and all lower Rigging new
