REPAIRS all the throat bolts and the next bolt of the hanging knees to hold beams renewed with copper, two additional pair of iron hanging knees to the hold beams under the brake, the head taken down & not replaced a gunnery knee fitted and a pair of stem knees for bolted up
Two new planks in the topsides in the larboard bow & all new planks in the starboard side in the topsides from the stem to their original shafts, one new quarter timber on the Port side aft and one timber on the starboard side near quarter timber, all the short bolts of brake renewed & new stem bolting and an additional iron breasthook over the hawse pipes & under bowsprit
