REPAIRS

Now done under Special Survey Rule Sec 54.60 with a view to re classing *R.P.

The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Tolt. Ship hung in shores and Caulked outside entirely, the Wales wholly scraped bright and the Trab Doubling new in 1846 scraped in plans sufficient to ascertain its condition.

The Decks, Coamings, Upper and Lower Deck Bolts, inside and outside Planking, Plank sheer, Waterway, Beams, knees, Hooks, Knightheads, Mainse Timbers, Keel, Keelson, Transoms, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and appear to be in good condition.
