## REPAIRS

Now done in complying with Special Survey for Continuation Rule Sec N<sup>o</sup> 54. The Outside Planking from lower part of Wale upwards scraped bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination, all the Treennails from lower part of Wale upwards replaced with new, all the "in and out" Bolts of Waterway upon Lower Deck Beams renewed with Iron, also the Bolts in Lower Deck Stooks and in the Throats of Hold Beam Hanging Knees, the Ship Caulked from Yellow Metal upwards.

The Deck, Coamings Deck and Hold Beam (or Lower Deck) Bolts inside and outside Planking, Treennails, Plank sheer, Waterway, Beam, Knees, Hooks, Knight heads, Plank Timbers, Transoms, Keelson, Keel, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and are in good condition.
