## REPAIRS

at Present scraped bright from load water line up to gunwales and bolts and treenails driven out for survey and found <sup>sound</sup> and good - The upper deck and Comings and upper deck bolts and the outside plank thro which they pass the plank ribs waterways and beams the house timbers Ryehtthead breasthooks and transoms the floors and keelson the Ceiling inside and the frame and inner surface of the outside plank where seen are sound and good and the keel straight and the sheer and general form unaltered - Requirements of Rule Sect 54 Complied with
