REPAIRS

at the present time under Special Survey Rule ^{4th} for Continuation Section N^o 54. Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Felt aloft and Paper below. Ship hung in Shrou and Caulked Outside. The Planking from lower part of Wale upwards scraped bright. Treennails and Iron Bolt driven out at various parts. For examination, 10 feet of Topside and an After Hood of Black Slate new on the Port side, five Bolts of some Dub Loozing knees replaced with new of Y Metal. The whole of Main Keelson new of African Oak, and the Pintles of Rudder refastened.

The Deck, Coamings, Dub and Hold Beam Bolts inside and Outside Planking, Treennails, Planks sheer Waterway Beam knees, Hooks, Knight Heads, Hamsse Timbers, Keel, Keelson Transom, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined by us and are in good condition, her original Form appears preserved.
