Now done under Special Survey Rule Sec 54.60 with a view to obtaining the distinction of ~~X~~ at the termination of the present year

The Outside Planking from lower part of Wales upwards scraped bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination. Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Felt, 20 feet of False Keel new. Ship hung in shoes and caulked outside all Iron Throat Bolts of Lower Deck. Hanging knees replaced with Bolts of Yellow Metal, three Stakes, Topsides and Deck repaired by Piecing, seven Bolts in each of the three lower Breast hooks, renewed with Copper, a new Breast Hook added in Hold.

The Deck, Coamings, Upper and Lower Deck Bolts, inside and outside Planking, Treennails, Plank sheer Waterway, Beams, knees, Hooks, Knight head, House Timbers, Transoms, Keel, Keelson, Floors and Timbers of the Frame ~~where they may be seen~~ have been examined by us and appear to be in good condition
