REPAIRS at Present bottom stripped Caulked and kedged with yellow Metal on felt Caulked from wales to gun wale all new throat bolts of the hanging knees of hold beams of yellow Metal & of the upper deck beams of iron. Walls topsides & sheerstrakes scraped bright and found sound & good bolts also good the bottom Plank is bolted with Copper without greenails and the upper work with iron bolts. Rules Sect. 52, & 60 Complied with the upper deck and covering the outside & ceiling Planks Plank sheers waterways and beams the house timbers, Knight heads breasthooks transoms the floors & keelson where seen are sound & good & sheer & general form unaltered
