Renewed - one length New Hog Kelson fitted Amidships  
Caulked from the Yellow Metal up. Yellow Metal repaired  
New Main Mast put in  
This Vessel was Stripped and a Part New Main Kal  
fitted and Plank of bottom shifted and bottom Caulked  
and Sheathed with Copper in 1849 at Moulmein from  
having been on shore there - She grounded on Coming  
out of Dock at Moulmein but on Examination  
now ~~no damage~~ <sup>she</sup> was found to have sustained no damage
