REPAIRS

at present five lengths of Ceiling Plank on each side above the belys renewed of English oak 6 new chocks fitted on the Starboard side & 5 on the larboard side treenails renewed thro' new Ceiling yellow metal renewed on both belys and uncovered seams Caulked - The wales topsides and sheerstrakes scraped bright and bolts and treenails found sound & good - The Ligatures of Ribs Sect 52, & 60 Complied with the upper deck and Comings the upper deck bolts the outside planks and Ceiling the plank sheers waterways and beams through the hooks & transoms the floors & keelson the frame timbers but face of the outside planking where seen are sound & good & the general form appears unaltered
