PAIRS At the present time, shipped - 4 pairs of additional iron hanging knees to stop deck beams and the wood knees of some deck additionally bolted to the beams, some new fore and aft to ceiling between the two lower decks at the bows, a new piece upon Breast Hook at the deck above. The ceiling repaired in places. Some new spunkitting for and new trucks and cables to the House, the Head Knee taken down the bolts off and clinched an entire new Head with knees & cheeks, five shifts of Black Strake several new posts of planks and pine upperworks, one new length of Plank Sheer - one new piece Waterway the materials used mostly E. I. Teak. The four main beams repaired additional at both in the topsides and beamed from the keel up over all including Mouldings and sheathed with yellow metal -
