at present wales topsides and sheerstrakes scraped bright and bolts and treenails driven out for survey and found sound & good - The lumber strakes have now been thro bolted with $\frac{3}{4}$ " yellow metal bolts - The caulking of the bottom over hauled and found firm & good - All the requisites of Rules Section 54 - Complied with - The upper deck and Ceiling the upper deck bolts and outside & Ceiling Plank the Plank sheer waterways and beams the haube timbers Knight heads breasthooks and transoms the floors & Nelson the frame and inner surface of the outside planking where seen are sound & good and the sheer & general form appear unaltered
