REPAIRS

Two forepiece of Rider Nelson extending abaft the foremast, the bulk
 bolts in the lower shake of wales, punched & plugged and a through bolt
 of yellow metal in the next timbers, a solid piece fitted at the heels
 of the last timbers aft & through bolted from side to side, caulked from
 the keel to the gunwale & yellow metal over felt

Several bolts & treenails driven out in various places for examination
 and found in good condition as well as the planks through which
 they pass, the plank sheers, waterway, beams, hawse timbers,
 knight heads, breast hooks, transoms, floors & keelsons, planking
 outside & inside are all in a sound & efficient state, the keel is
 straight & has preserved her original form & sheer,
