REPAIRS at present from damage thro stress of weather all new rails bulwarks and wrought-iron Stanchions (12 on each side) from fore rigging forward on both sides the flare out of these Stanchions reduced 18 inches on each side - stem additionally bolted topsides and parts of deck Caulked - the yellow metal sheathing raised on that all round
