REPAIRS at present one length new Sheerstrake aft on both sides all the in front bolts of upper deck Rains new of iron those of the lower deck new of yellow metal one new fore hood of bottom on each side next the keels timbers. Sound stem additionally bolted one new external iron hook fitted behind the head - a pair of new pointers fitted to stern frame new fore step fitted wales topsides and sheerstrakes scraped bright and bottom stripped Caulked & sheathed with yellow metal on felt - trimails and bolts driven out for survey and where defective renewed
