at present bottom stripped and three fore hoods of bottom on larboard side next under the Wale New of Amer Oak and 3 after hoods also new on same side found the fast port timbers and transoms exposed sound & good treenails renewed from the wales to the bilges one new plank in the wales on the Starboard side and bolts renewed two new planks in topsides timbers good Ceiling renewed bottom and wales Caulked - Wale's topsides and sheer strakes scraped bright and bolts & treenails driven out for survey and both renewed where defective - the upper deck
