REPAIRS At Seghorn in June last, had new decks, part new waterways nearly all new topsides & wales, part new upper course of bottom, several new top timbers, new stern frame, four new transoms new fashion pieces, side counter timbers, six new deck beams 40 new lodging benches, new ceiling from clamps to the second plank below the hold beams, part new deck clamps, new stern and new lower masts.

At the present the sd work scraped bright & caulked from the Copper to the gunwale, & two iron pointers fitted aft.
