REPAIRS

At the present time under Special Survey for Continuation Rule Sec No 54. The Outside planking from Sheathing upwards, scraped bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination. The following are new viz a Fore Head of Sheer Stake Stair, and a Plank in Midship of d^o, one Hamse Timber in this Bow, upper piece of Stem and the Lower Deck Hook, all of the highest class materials; the second Breast Hook up is new of Iron upon Wood Knees, and the whole Knee of Head with all belonging to it is new. New work Caulked and Y Metal Sheathing repaired.

The Decks, Coamings, Decks and Hold Beam Bolts, inside and outside planking, Treennails, Planksheer Waterway, Beams, Hooks, Knight Heads, Hamse Timbers, Transoms, Keel, Keelson, Floors and Timbers of the Frame have been examined where they may be seen, and appear to be in good condition.
