Now done, a Special Survey held at request of Agent for Owners and Report made to them of damages sustained by Collision, and by grounding off Harwich, in her passage from Smyrna to Stettin. The necessary Repairs of damage are not extensive, and have not been entered upon.

A Large portion of the Ceiling below First Putt-heads (American Elm) being decayed it was removed, and the Floors (American Oak) and First Puttheads (Larch) generally proving to be badly decayed, the Repair is altogether abandoned in London. The Vessel to be taken home to Belfast. The Outside Planking should be brightened for examination.
